- 2. Certificate from the Board from which he/she passed the High School/Higher Secondary Examination, showing his/her date of birth.
- 3. Certificate/Mark sheet from the Board from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examination showing that he/she has secured 60% or more marks (50% in case of SC/ST/Persons & 45% for person with Benchmark Disability) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- 4. Migration Certificate from the University/Board last attended by him/her.

Applicable only to candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe/OBC/EWS/ OPH Category.

- a. SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority. Community should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
- b. OBC Certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the central list of OBC. OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy layer. OBC certificate must be in the prescribed format. (The OBC certificates issued from 1" April, 2022 (inclusive) and start of reporting of Round- 1 of MBBS counselling (as per Medical Counselling Committee for MBBS admission) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2023.
- c. EWS Certificate issued by the competent authority. The EWS certificates issued from 1" April, 2022 (inclusive) and start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counselling (as per Medical Counselling Committee for MBBS admission) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2023.
- d. Certificate from prescribed authority showing that he/she belongs to Persons with Benchmark Disability Category.

Those candidates who join MBBS course at AIIMS, Bathinda, his/her Original certificates will be retained and the same will not be returned to the candidate before completion of the course.
