

Fire Safety Week – Day 04 Report

As part of the ongoing Fire Safety Week 2026, various fire safety awareness sessions, mock drills, technical learning activities, and fire safety audits were successfully conducted Under the guidance of respected **Executive Director Prof. Dr. Ratan Gupta**, on 07/05/2026 across different critical areas of the institute.

The activities were organized with the objective of enhancing fire safety preparedness, spreading awareness among healthcare workers, and ensuring compliance with fire safety protocols in critical hospital infrastructure areas.

Activities Conducted

1. Fire Safety Awareness Class – IPD C Block, G/F

Time: 10:00 AM to 10:30 AM

A fire safety awareness class was conducted at the IPD C Block in the esteemed presence of the **Executive Director Prof. Dr. Ratan Gupta**, along with **Nodal Officer Dr. Vaibhav Saini, Dr. Bharat Udey Associate Professor, Dept. of Psychiatry and Dr. Jawahar Singh Associate Professor, Dept. of Psychiatry.**

The session focused on basic fire prevention measures, emergency evacuation procedures, and the importance of quick response during fire emergencies. Staff members were educated regarding the use of firefighting equipment and emergency reporting procedures.

2. Fire Safety Awareness Class & Mock Drill – Emergency Neuro Critical Area

Time: 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM

A fire safety awareness class and mock drill were conducted at the Emergency Neuro Critical Area under the supervision of **Dr. Purushottam, Associate Professor, Dept of Hospital Administration.**

The training included demonstrations on emergency response, safe evacuation techniques, handling of fire extinguishers, and immediate response actions during fire incidents in critical patient care areas.

3. Fire Safety Awareness Class & Mock Drill – Main OT Complex

Time: 02:00 PM to 02:30 PM

A fire safety awareness session and mock drill were organized at the Main OT Complex under the guidance of **Prof. (Dr.) Anju Grewal Head, Dept. of Anaesthesiology** and it was conducted in the presence of **Prof. (Dr.) Anuradha Raj, Head, Dept. of Ophthalmology, Nodal Officer Dr. Vaibhav Saini and Dr Mohammed Luqman.**

The session emphasized fire prevention measures in operation theatre environments, safe handling of electrical equipment, and emergency evacuation protocols for critical patients and staff.

Fire Mock Drill Audit Report – OT Complex

Focus: Patient Safety and Emergency Response

A comprehensive fire mock drill audit was conducted in the Operation Theatre Complex under the supervision of Dr. Mohd Luqman to evaluate preparedness during fire emergencies. A simulated fire incident was created in OT-4 to assess response time, coordination among staff members, evacuation procedures, and technical safety systems.

Doctors and OT staff were briefed regarding fire safety protocols, preventive measures, and emergency evacuation procedures. During the simulation, staff demonstrated prompt response, efficient coordination, and proper use of firefighting equipment for immediate containment and safe evacuation.

During the audit, it was observed that most safety protocols and response mechanisms were functioning satisfactorily; however, certain deficiencies requiring corrective action were identified:

Failure of the Code Red alarm system during simulation, requiring immediate repair and testing of fire alarm circuitry by the Engineering Department.

Absence of green fluorescent “Fire Exit” strips for low-light visibility, requiring installation of photoluminescent exit signage by the Hospital Administration.

The audit concluded that while staff preparedness and response were commendable, immediate rectification of the identified technical deficiencies is essential for ensuring complete fire safety compliance within the OT complex.

4. Technical Webinar Organized by MoHFW

Time: 03:00 PM to 04:00 PM

The Engineering Team and Fire Safety Team attended the technical webinar organized by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW).

The webinar covered the following important **topics**:

Fire Safety Regulations for Healthcare Facilities

Hospital Fire Safety Plan

The webinar provided valuable insights regarding statutory fire safety compliance, hospital emergency preparedness planning, and best practices for healthcare fire safety management.

5. Fire Safety Audit

Areas Covered: ESS1, Transformer Area, HVAC Plant, DG Area

Time: 05:30 PM to 06:30 PM

A detailed fire safety audit was carried out in the ESS1, Transformer Area, HVAC Plant, and DG Area to inspect the availability and functionality of firefighting systems, electrical safety measures, emergency access routes, and overall compliance with fire safety standards.

6. Electrical Audit cum Fire Safety Mock Drill

An Electrical Audit cum Fire Safety Mock Drill was conducted under the supervision of **Mr. Pawan Kuamr, Assistant Engineer AC & R & Electric**. The audit included inspection of electrical loads, load balancing assessment, electrical panel parameter checks, and identification of unsafe electrical practices across various hospital areas.

Staff members were educated regarding electrical fire hazards, safe electrical usage, prevention of overloading, importance of proper earthing, and emergency response in case of electrical faults. Demonstrations regarding electrical panel parameters, MCB/MCCB safety devices, and preventive maintenance practices were also provided.

Conclusion

The Day 04 activities of Fire Safety Week 2026 were conducted successfully with active participation from healthcare workers, engineering staff, fire safety personnel, and

administrative officials. The sessions and audits significantly contributed towards strengthening fire safety awareness, emergency preparedness, and institutional safety standards across critical areas of the hospital campus.

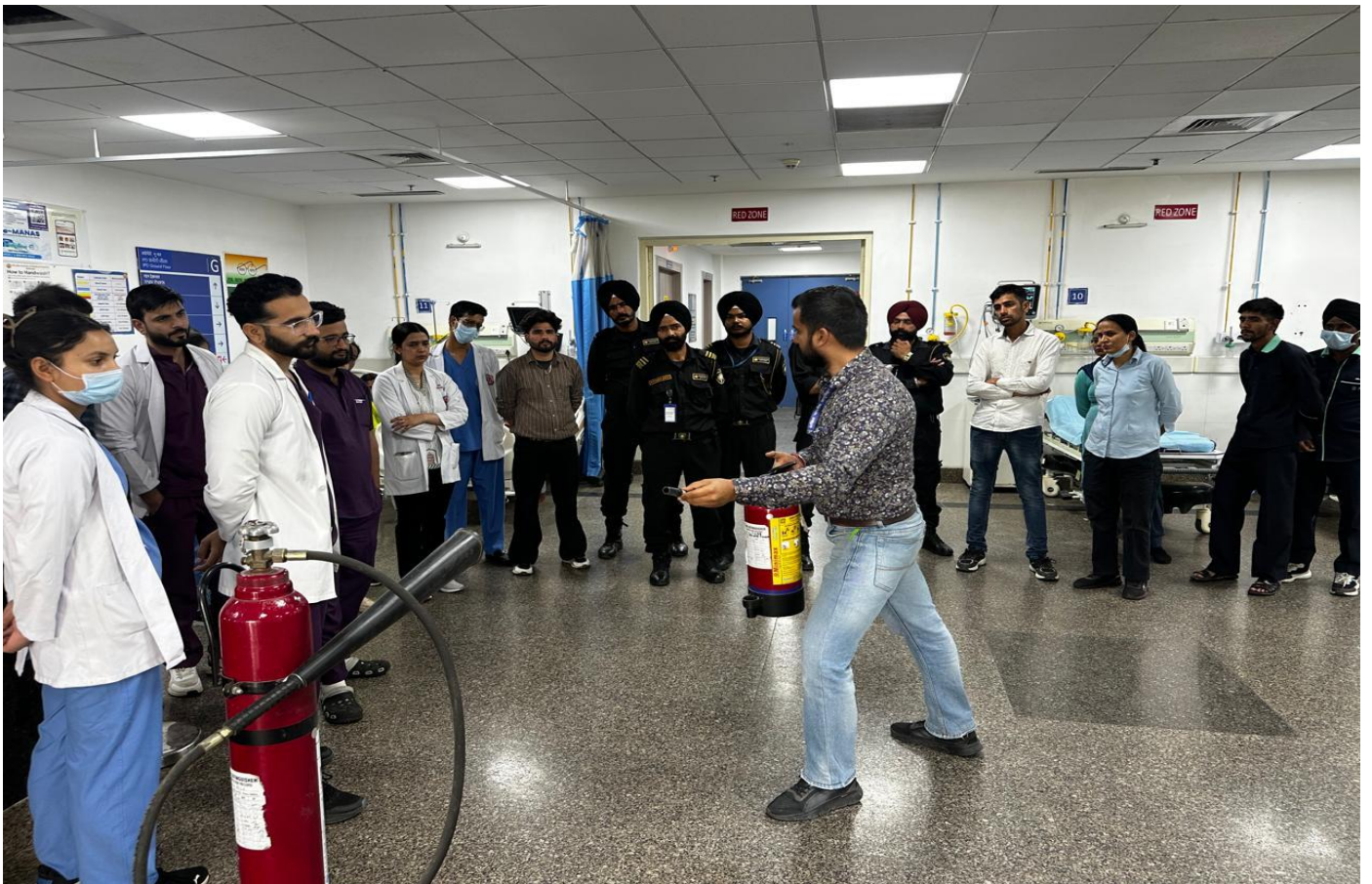

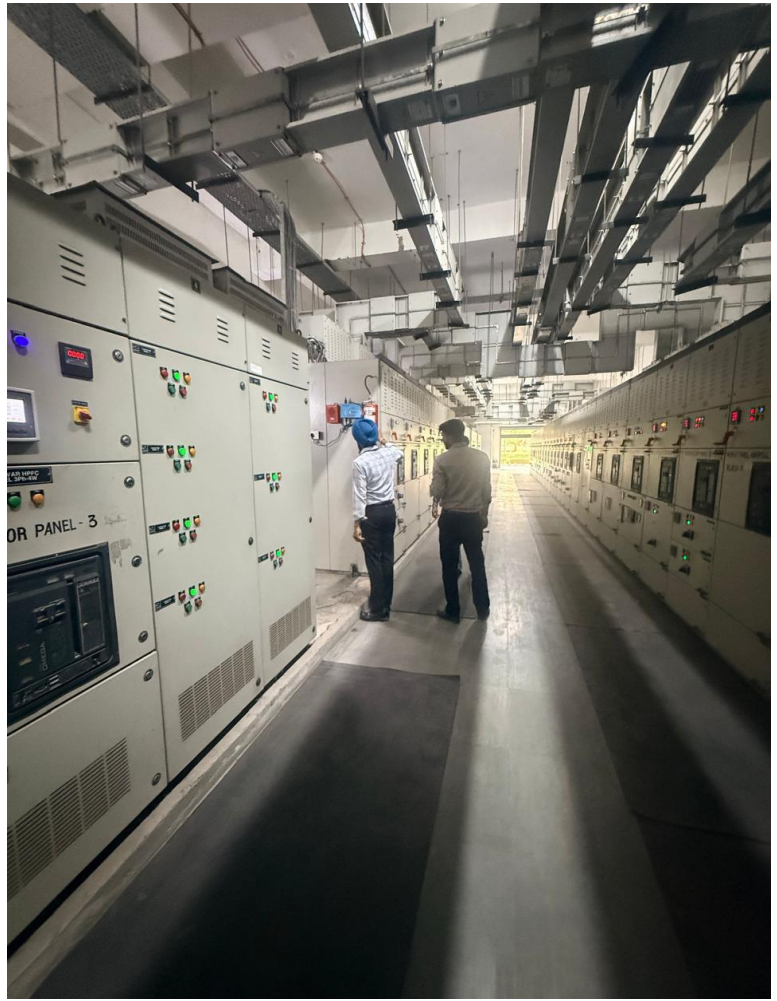

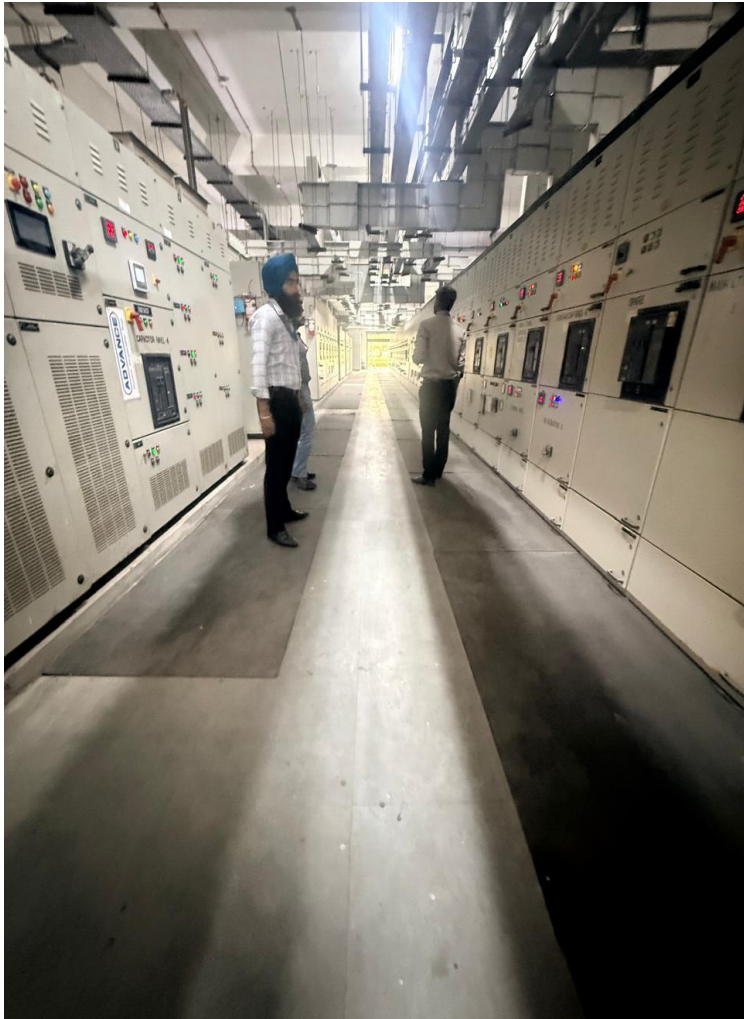
