1. Hazard Identification Drive – “Identify and Report Fire Risks”

Time: 09:30 AM to 11:00 AM

A Hazard Identification Drive was conducted by the Fire & Safety Team along with **Mr. Ashish Gupta, Assistant Engineer Civil**.

During the activity, various fire risk areas were inspected and staff members were encouraged to identify and report potential fire hazards within their respective work areas.

The drive focused on:

Identification of electrical and combustible hazards

Inspection of escape routes and emergency exits

Awareness regarding safe housekeeping practices

Reporting procedures for unsafe conditions and fire risks

The activity helped in improving awareness among staff regarding proactive fire prevention measures and workplace safety compliance.
