CIRCULAR

Subject: Invitation of applications for allotment of one unit of Type II on medical grounds.

1. It is stated that vide Office Order No. AIIMS/BTI/Estate/OO/404 dated 24 Mar, 2022 and Office Order No. AIIMS/BTI/Estate/OO/427 dated 13 Apr 2022, a committee was constituted to examine and recommend the cases for allotment of Type I to Type IV accommodation on medical grounds under the chairmanship of the Head of Department, Dept. of OBGY, AIIMS Bathinda.
2. At present, **01 Nos. of Type II accommodation** have been earmarked for allotment to Nursing Officers Gr II on medical grounds.
3. In order to provide equal opportunity, applications are invited from **Senior Nursing Officers, Nursing Officers Gr II and regular non-faculty staff** for vacant Type II accommodation, who fulfills the criteria for allotment of accommodation on medical grounds, so that their case can be submitted before the Committee for consideration. The last date of receipt of applications in Estate Office (C Block, 2nd Floor, Medical College) is 21 Mar 2024 [17:00 hrs].
4. Copy of guidelines for allotment of accommodation on medical grounds is attached with this circular. Applicants are to ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria for medical grounds as per the guidelines attached. Form for applying is attached with this circular.
5. This is with the approval of the competent authority of the Institute.

ANNEXURE - I

Annexure referred to in Para. 3 (iv) of the O.M. No. 12035/2/97-Pol. II, (Pt. II), dated 17-11-1997:— TO

Medical Grounds

The allotment on medical grounds including ground floor / central area shall be made in the case of the Government servants and their spouse, dependent children and dependent parents, suffering from any of the following diseases:

- (a) **Tuberculosis:** Pulmonary tuberculosis (serious cases only).
- (b) **Cancer Cases:** Malignant neoplasm.
- (c) **Heart ailments:** Of an exceptionally serious nature and in need of urgent treatment.
- (d) **Disabled persons:**
 - (i) **Blind:—** Those who suffer from either of the following conditions:—
 - (1) Total absence of sight.

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- (2) Visual Acuity not exceeding 6/90 or 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses.
- (3) Impression of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degrees or worse;
- (ii) **Deaf:** Those having hearing loss of more than 90 decibels in the better ear (profound impairment) or total loss of hearing in both ears.
- (iii) **Orthopaedically handicapped:** To the extent of 40% and above disability.
- (iv) **Mentally handicapped / spastic dependants.**

NOTE.— (1) The list of diseases, on the basis of which discretionary allotment may be considered as above, is not an exhaustive one. The Committees may consider any other life threatening diseases or other serious disabilities causing permanent impairment, for this purpose.

NOTE.— (2) In cases where disability of dependent parents is the sole ground for asking for discretionary allotment, the Committees should consider the facts and circumstances along with merits of each case carefully, before making their recommendations.
