Important Instructions

1. There will be a screening examination for the post of **Technician (Radiotherapy) Grade II** scheduled on **7th Sep 2022**, from **10 AM to 11 AM**.

Venue: - Examination Hall 2nd Floor of Medical College

2. Candidate should report at 9:00 am. The candidate would not be allowed to enter the examination hall after **9:30 AM on the day of Examination.**

3. The Examination will be of MCQs type of 50 Questions of 1 hour, with 1 question of 4 marks. <u>1 mark will be deducted for an incorrect Answer.</u>

4. The marks of the written test would not be counted for interview for the selection of **post of**

Technician (Radiotherapy) Grade II and Selection will be post based on performance in the Interview only.

5. The candidates are instructed to bring **one original valid ID proof** (Aadhaar Card/ Pan card / Driving Licences/ voter Id/Passport) without which they would not be allowed to sit in the examination of post of **Technician (Radiotherapy) Grade II**.

6. Syllabus of Examination: All subjects of B.Sc. Radiotherapy/Radiography.

7. Mobile and other electronic gadgets are not allowed in the examination hall.

8. You have to bring your own blue pen.

9. Candidates are required to follow COVID-19 guidelines as issued by Govt. of India, from time to time.

10. Result of screening test will be declared on the same day and **only shortlisted** candidates will be allowed to appear for the interview on the same day.
