

### Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2025/B/6928495-C7

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

#### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Experience Certificate for the supply of the same to any Govt/ PSU/ any renowned private organisation along with Supply/ Purchase Order.
2. If the agency is registered under MSME or NSIC, then EMD exemption certificate needs to be enclosed.
3. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
  1. The bidder may be asked for a demonstration during the technical evaluation failing of which may lead to disqualify in participation.
  2. The EMD/PBG/Invoices should be issued in favour of Executive Director AIIMS Bathinda.
  3. The bidder to be submit Pre-Contract Integrity Pact duly notarised on Non Judicial Stamp paper of Rs 1 00 as uploaded in Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC.
  4. EMD Exemption: Under the MSE category, only manufacturers of the goods/products offered are eligible for exemption from EMD. Traders are excluded from the purview of this policy.
  5. The warranty of the product should be 2 years and CMC of 8 years after the warranty period as per the latest guidelines by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt of India issued vide Z-28016/35/2024-PM SSY-IV-Part(1) (8288538) dated 30 Aug 2024.
  6. The Technical Specifications of the item will be acceptable strictly as per the specifications uploaded under 'Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC'.

#### 7. The following points of the Technical Specifications to be read as:

##### Point No. 1. a)

ICU ventilators provide artificial respiratory support to the critical patients in all types of Intensive Care Units with altitude compensation for volume and BTS correction for monitoring. The ventilator should power on self test / calibration for flow sensor, O2 sensor, PEEP valve, leakage, circuit compliance, humidifier type selection etc. for checking the ventilator. Should be US FDA approved / EU CE / BIS Certified.

##### Point No 3. a)

Volume-controlled, Pressure-controlled and/or PC-VG.

##### Point 3. b)

Pressure Support with assured volume, or VAPS, or PC-PS

**Point No 4. b)**

Should have coloured touch screen 12 inch or more and rotary knob for dual control.

**Point No. 4. h)**

Should have Trending facility for 72 hours minimum, Alarm log for 1000 events including alarm, setting of ventilator parameters etc.

**Point 5. a)**

Tidal Volume 10ml to 1500ml or more.

**Point No 6. h)**

Plateau Pressure, leak Mv, leak%, Time constant, spont. MV Spont RR

**Point no. 6. j)**

Should have facility for SBT or Stress Index.

**Point No 7. c)**

Non-forced Slow Vital Capacity, or RSBI, or Imposed work of Breathing (WOBi), or Lung Monitoring

**Point No 12.**

Should have High Visibility Numeric Screen (only digits) /Monitoring screen with all parameters, Leak compensation in all operative's modes and can be switched ON/OFF.

**Point No 14.**

Should have battery backup of minimum 30 minutes for main ventilator unit.

**Point 15.**

Should have RS 232 / RJ45/ USB interface for communication with networked devices

## Point No. 18. a)

Ventilator main unit Should be US FDA or European CE or BIS approved product for Class IIB. The supplier should be ISO certified.

## Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
